

PASTORAL COMMITTEES

Building and Grounds Committee—assesses the buildings and grounds and presents assessments and recommendations to the Parish Council. Responsible for administration, maintenance and repair of the physical property and the upgrading of said property.

Liturgy Committee—assists the Pastor in the spiritual formation and development of the liturgical and spiritual life and activities of the Parish. The focus is to provide a means for spiritual growth within the Parish.

Mission Committee—assists with the collection of items and funds for the Missionary needs overseas.

Public Relations Committee—responsible for maintaining open communications throughout the parish. This includes maintaining web site, preparation of parish newsletter, distribution of information to new parishioners, etc.

Welcoming Committee—responsible for visiting with and welcoming new Parishioners to our Parish Family. If a personal visit is not possible, members are required to mail the packets to the new members of our Parish.

Communication Committee—primary function is to facilitate communication between committees and present that information to the Parish as a whole. Instruments of communication include but are not limited to: the Parish website, the bulletin and the formation of a Parish-wide newsletter. Computer skills are a plus. Please consider serving on this important committee. We need members who are dedicated to improving and expanding the communication throughout our Parish Family.

School Advisory Council—Members include parents of children in our school and at least one at-large parish member.

Social Concerns Committee—provides for the fostering and nurturing of “community” within the parish and of “social justice” within the community. The committee concerns itself with fostering and developing those activities which provide for the fulfilling of the Christian life and legacy among members of the parish and the community.

Stewardship Committee—organize, maintain and present our annual Stewardship drive, necessary to carry out the pastoral activities of the parish. This function must be approached not only from a need (fund drives, etc.) point of view, but also from the spiritual obligation point of view.

Time and Talent Coordinator/Committee—responsible for gathering, sorting and maintaining the Stewardship Time and Talent Survey. Also makes adjustments to the physical survey as needed for future development of the parish.

Strategic Planning Committee—specific purpose is to develop a parish wide short term and long term master plan for the Parish and coordinate the planning and execution of new construction on parish grounds.

PARISH FUNDRAISING COMMITTEES AND OPPORTUNITIES

Annual Auction Committee—a group of dedicated people who’s primary focus is to plan and execute the Parish Auction which is held each year. Our annual Auction generates vital parish-wide resources and is a much valued event. It is fun for all, including those who put so much time and effort into the planning each year. The volunteers and people of our Parish, and community who donate their time and the many fine auction items, help to make this event very successful. The committee welcomes new members to participate in the planning process. There are many different needs including meal planning, decorations, promotional materials, solicitation of items and volunteer coordination. Meeting times will be posted in the bulletin. You only need to attend to become a member of this fine group of volunteers.

Annual Golf Classic Committee—is a school fundraising committee that plans and organizes the Annual Golf Classic which raises money for the school operating budget. It is a very successful event and a lot of fun for everyone involved.

Annual Parish Bazaar—organized by the Altar Society, this event is a long standing tradition at Queen of the Holy Rosary—Wea. It is held in the Fall of each year

DESCRIPTIONS AND DEFINITIONS

Knights of Columbus—a faith-based organization of men, age 18 and older. The Council provides activities that encourage and support our Parish Community.

Men’s Club—dedicated to social fellowship among all men within the parish. Any male parish member over 18 years of age is eligible to join.

Altar Society—dedicated to social fellowship among all women within the parish. Any female parish member over 18 years of age is eligible to join. The Altar Society supports the parish in many ways including conducting the Annual Parish Bazaar held each Fall.

Perpetual Adoration—constant prayer before the Blessed Sacrament, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Your willingness to choose an assigned hour is a precious expression of your faith that Jesus, in the Blessed Sacrament, is welcomed, loved, and adored by you.

Lead Couple for Marriage Preparation—Primary function is to meet with couples preparing for marriage. Topics of discussion could include budgeting, communication, faith, sexuality, careers and conflict with in-laws. Five sessions per couple required.

Queen’s Quilters—a small group of QHR women sharing a common interest in quilting.

Catechist—one who teaches Christian doctrine, especially within a parish.

Catechumenate—the period of instruction in the faith before baptism and admission of converts to the Catholic Church.

Catechumenate Sponsor—An individual who sponsors an adult during the period of instruction and involvement in the Catholic faith in preparation for reception into the Catholic Church.

RCIA—Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults—the period of instruction and involvement in the Catholic faith in preparation for reception into the Catholic Church.
